This year we have completed a number of projects which include:

- provision of a water supply at Fforest Road Allotments;
- commemorative benches at Tylagarw and in Llanharry;
- Improved the entrance way to the playing field;
- Secured the eastern boundary of the playing field with a gate and railings.

We have also installed a small kitchen in the Ambulance Hall which means that the hall can be hired out for meetings, gatherings and small parties. Please contact 01443 223007 for further details. Hopefully by the time you receive this newsletter the purchase of land to extend the Cemetery will be nearing completion. During the year the only remaining cherry tree in the playing field had to be removed for safety reasons but the Chairman, out of her civic allowance, paid for six mature trees in the area, two of which are flowering cherry trees.

Projects 2016-2017

One of the most important projects for the coming financial year is a joint project with RCTCBC for the provision of a pre-school play area for Tylagarw, hopefully this year this project will go ahead. We have also earmarked money for the decoration of the Ambulance Hall so that it becomes an attractive venue to hold small events. We also plan to install a new piece of equipment at the play area and funding for the cleaning of the play surfaces and multi use games area along with the renewal of the court markings. The Youth shelter and play equipment will be re-painted this year to keep it in tip-top condition. Llanharry Community Council has also committed to paying for the annual Firework display which is held in November.

Parking—Speeding

Motorists are reminded about not parking on the pedestrian crossing/zig—zag lines/bus stop or too close to the junction of the Bear Inn. Doing so poses a danger to other motorists and pedestrians.

Motorists are also reminded that the maximum speed through the village is 30mph and 40mph down Red Hill!
