4. DISCUSS THE PROVISION OF LIGHTING AND RAILINGS FOR THE WAR MEMORIAL

Resolved: to apply to RCTCBC for permission to erect lighting and railings.

Railings to be approximately 12" high, galvanised ball top to match existing railings at the playing field; sited approximately 15" from base of memorial. Lighting to be installed to light all faces of memorial, sourced ideally (with permission from Street Lighting) from the nearest lighting column.

Councillor Owen informed members that he had purchased two 5ft tall metal silent soldiers, one for Llanharry and one for Tylagarw. It was decided to site the silent soldier on the corner of the flower beds facing the memorial.
